

Civil Engineering Scheduling Plan

To assist the department in making effective use of university resources and to minimize avoidable delays in their progress toward graduation, students are advised to plan their courses far in advance. Many required civil engineering courses are offered every semester. However, in order to make efficient use of resources as this program matures, a several courses, selected to have minimal impact on student progress, are offered only once a year. A list of courses planned to be offered once a year and the semester of offering is given in the table below.
